AGREED MINUTES

1. A delegation representing the Government of the Republic of Chile and a delegation representing jointly the Governments of the Kingdoms of Denmark, Norway and Sweden met in Copenhagen on 24-25 April 2001 to discuss a modernisation of the bilateral Air Services Agreements between their respective countries.

Lists of the delegations are attached as Appendix I and II.

The discussions were held in a very friendly atmosphere.

- 2. The delegations agreed upon and initialled English texts of revised bilateral Air Services Agreements between the respective Governments of Chile and Denmark, Norway and Sweden. The texts are attached as Appendix III.
- 3. The delegations also agreed upon and initialled the text of a Memorandum of Understanding between the respective Parties relative to the revised bilateral Air Services Agreements about the co-operation regarding Scandinavian Airlines System (SAS). This Memorandum is attached as Appendix IV.
- 4. Recognizing that completion of the formalities for entry into force of the Agreements and the Memorandum may require some time, the delegations agreed that they will give immediate practical effect to the ad referendum Agreements and the ad referendum Memorandum to the extent possible under national law, pending the entry into force of the Agreements and the Memorandum.
- 5. The delegations declared that the third Party codesharing referred to in Paragraph 4b of the Annexes, in case of a through service by an airline designated by one of the Contracting Parties, would be allowed by the other Contracting Party only if the third Party airline holds traffic rights on the codeshared sector.
