### 3. Connection to Denmark

Applicant(s) is/are resident or domiciled in Denmark or in another state where the person(s) in question cannot be registered owner of an aircraft because of his/her nationality  $\mathbf{or}$ 

Applicant(s) is/are EU or EEC national(s)/company(ies) with connection to Denmark by virtue of the EU regulations on the free movement for workers within the Community, the right to establishment or freedom to provide services  $\mathbf{or}$

Application for exemption shall be submitted to the Danish Civil Aviation and Railway Authority together with the other documentation, cf. below.

## 4. Documentation etc. - to be submitted with the application

Documentation for the applicant's/applicants' right to the aircraft (original Bill of Sale, the Danish Civil Aviation and Wailway Authority's Declaration of Transfer of Ownership in original or the like)

Notification from the registration authorities of the exporting country stating that the aircraft has been removed from that country's register and giving information about latest registered owner and whether the aircraft is mortgaged, or that it has never been registered

Third party liability insurance (the insurance company/broker must have been approved by the Danish Financial Supervisory Authority) – must meet the requirements in Regulation (EC) no. 785/2004 of 21 April 2004 as amended by Regulation (EU) no. 285/2010 of 6 April 2010

Documentation for the authority of the signer/signers to sign on behalf of the applicant (for foreign companies: Notarization of the application; For clubs: Copy of articles and signed minutes from the latest general meeting; For partnerships: Copy of partnership contract)

Original, notarized Power of Attorney, if relevant

Application for exemption, if relevant

Original purchase document or justified declaration of value statement, in case no sale has taken place
Charge in Danish kroner:
(The charge constitutes $10/00$ of the sum of transfer of ownership/value of the aircraft. The amount shall be rounded up to the closest amount in Danish kroner divisible by $100$ , e.g. shall $749$ be rounded up to $800$ )
If the deal has been made in foreign currency, the following shall be informed:  Rate of exchange used Date of exchange
(An official average exchange rate fixed by the National Bank of Denmark within the last 14 days before the application of registration may be used.)
Copy of payment slip
The Danish Civil Aviation and Railway Authority will submit an invoice to the applicant(s) covering the issue fee for registration in accordance with the Order on fees and charges in the aviation area in force at any time.

### Purpose of processing your personal data

# Transfer to recipients in other countries, including to international organisations

In connection with the supervision of the Ministry of the Danish Civil Aviation and Railway Authority, ICAO (International Civil Aviation Organization) may require documents with your perso-nal data delivered as part of the audit. ICAO is a United Nations organization based in Canada.

### Filing of your personal data

The data the Authority may keep on record are regularly forwarded to the Danish National Archives in accordance with the rules of the Danish Archives Act and the provisions laid down by the Danish National Archives. Data we receive that are not subject to the Authority's duty to keep records will be deleted when we no longer need them.

### Your rights

According to the Data Protection Regulation, you have a number of rights regarding the processing of your personal data by us. If you want to exercise your rights, please contact us.

### Right to see your data

You have the right to see the data we process on you (the right of ac-cess to documents), or to apply for access to documents.

#### Right of correction

You have the right to have incorrect data on you corrected.

### Right of deletion

In special circumstances, you have the right to have data we hold on you deleted before the date on which we generally delete data. This only applies to data which we are not obliged to record.
