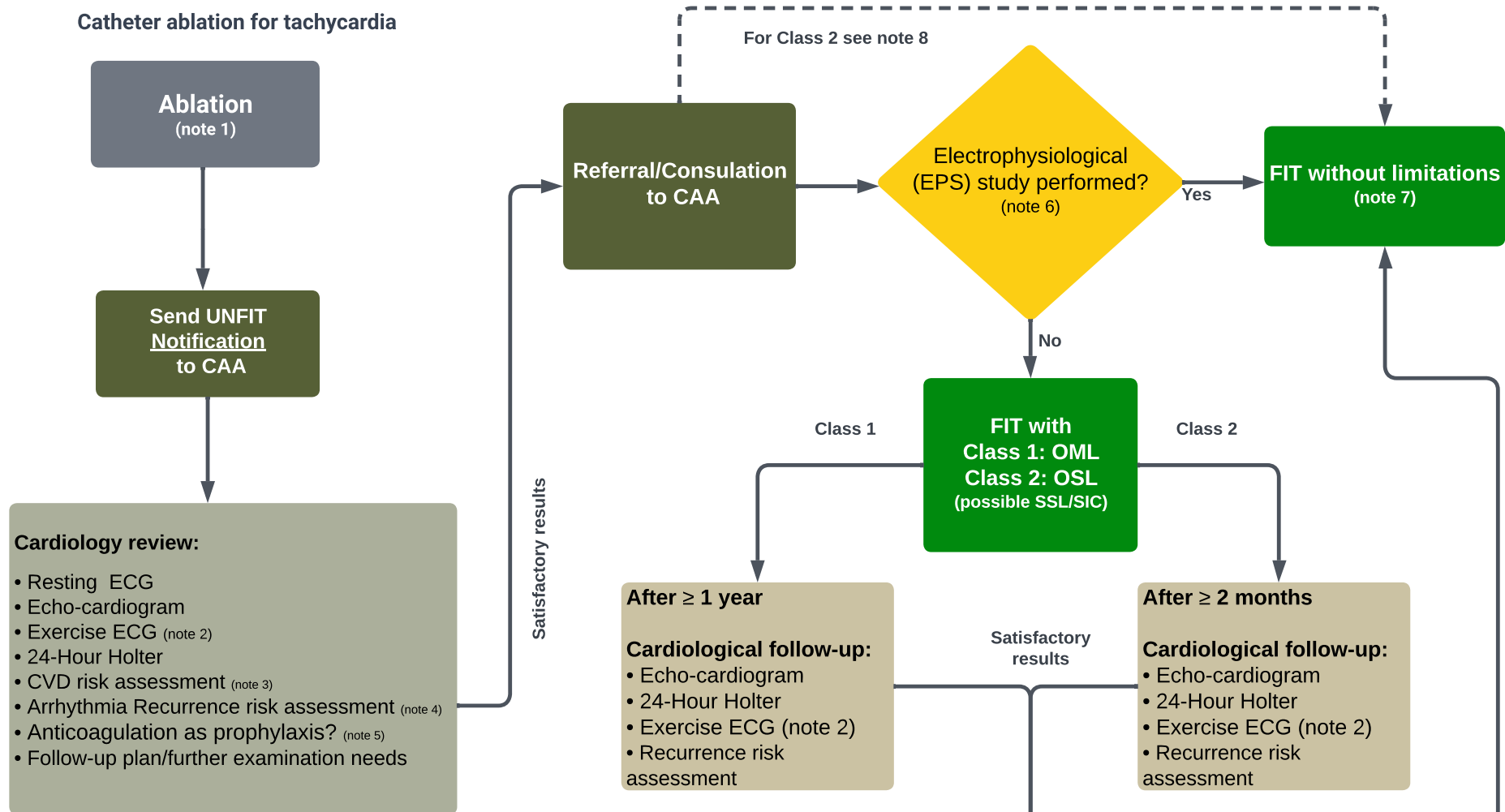


Ablation

Catheter ablation for tachycardia



NOTES

- (1) Documented successful.
- (2) Minimum 9 minutes duration of test with no significant abnormality of rhythm or conduction, nor evidence of ischemia. For Class 1/2 METS ≥ 10 must be achieved.
- (3) Assessment of Stroke and or Cardiac event Risk (in %) (ESC CVD risk App)
- (4) Statement from cardiologist (%)
- (5) Please follow regulation requirement for Thromboembolic disorders.
- (6) Electrophysiological study, undertaken at a **minimum of 2 months after the ablation**, demonstrates satisfactory results
- (7) Individual assessment after risk. For those whose long-term outcome cannot be assured by invasive or non-invasive testing, an additional period with an OML and/or observation may be necessary.
- (8) If primary cardiological review was undertaken 2 months after ablation procedure a Fit without OSL may be possible.
