

## AGREED MINUTES

1. A delegation representing jointly the Governments of the Kingdoms of Denmark, Norway and Sweden and a delegation representing the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand met in Copenhagen on 6 March 2008 to discuss bilateral air services relations between their respective countries.

Lists of the delegations are attached as Appendix I and II.

The discussions were held in a very friendly and cordial atmosphere.

2. The delegations agreed upon and initialled the text of the three new bilateral Air Services Agreements between the respective Governments of Thailand and Denmark, Norway and Sweden. The text is attached as Appendix III and is to supersede the three existing Air Services Agreements of 1949, respectively, as amended.


3. The delegations also agreed upon and initialled a Memorandum of Understanding between the four Parties related to the new Air Services Agreements on the co-operation regarding Scandinavian Airlines System (SAS) and on the designation of airlines. The Memorandum is to be signed on the same date as the Air Services Agreements. The Memorandum is attached as Appendix IV.

4. The Scandinavian delegation proposed to insert the European Union standard clause on fuel taxation in the Article on Customs Duties. The Scandinavian delegation also proposed the inclusion of 7<sup>th</sup> freedom traffic rights for all-cargo services. The Thai delegation, however, was not prepared to accept these proposals at this stage.

5. Both delegations agreed that the necessary domestic requirements should be made to the draft Air Services Agreements and the Memorandum to be signed as soon as possible.
