AGREED MINUTES

Delegations representing the Aeronautical Authorities of the Republic of Kazakhstan ("Kazakhstan") and the Aeronautical Authorities of Denmark, Norway and Sweden ("Denmark/Norway/Sweden"), met in Nassau, Bahamas, on 6 December 2016 to review their bilateral aviation and air transport relations.

The list of the members of the two Delegations is attached hereto as Enclosure 1.

The consultations were held during the ICAO Air Services Negotiation Event (ICAN2016) hosted from 5 to 9 December 2016 by the Ministry of Transport and Aviation of Bahamas.

As a result of these discussions, which were held in a cordial and friendly atmosphere, the two Delegations agreed on the following:

1. AIR SERVICES AGREEMENT

The Scandinavian delegation recalled the importance of having new Air Services Agreements that include all standard European Union clauses, including an EEA designation clause. The delegation of Kazakhstan stated its readiness to discuss it in turn order after the other European Union Member States.

Both delegations recognized the necessity of the establishment of a long-term legal framework for the operation of scheduled air services between their countries and agreed to initiate the procedure in order to conclude Air Services Agreements in the future.

2. OPERATIONS DURING THE INTERNATIONAL SPECIALIZED EXHIBITION EXPO-2017 IN ASTANA, KAZAKHSTAN

The delegations recalled the ASAs between the respective Scandinavian countries and Kazakhstan, intialled at Almaty on 26 April 1996, as amended, and provisionally applicable. These draft ASAs provide for the possibility for direct scheduled air services between Denmark, Norway and Sweden, respectively, and Kazakhstan, including during the International specialized Exhibition EXPO-2017 in Astana.

Should the need arise for air flights not covered by the initialled ASAs, the Scandinavian delegation stated that it would look favourably on applications for such flights.
