AGREED MINUTES

- A delegation representing the Government of the State of Kuwait and a delegation jointly representing the Governments of the Kingdoms of Denmark, Norway and Sweden met during ICAN2015 in Antalya, Turkey, on 23 October 2015 to discuss their civil aviation relations.
- 2. Lists of delegations are attached as Appendices I and II, respectively.
- 3. The talks were held in a very friendly and cordial atmosphere.
- 4. Recognizing the need for modernizing the Air Services Agreements (ASAs) signed between the Contracting Parties on 24 June 1976 ("the Agreements") and wishing to promote air transport between their respective countries, the delegations agreed on and initialed today new Air Services Agreements, which, for both passenger services and cargo services, include multiple designation of airlines, lifting of restrictions on capacity, open route lists, full 5th freedom rights on any intermediate points, liberalization of the tariff regime, and provisions on codeshare arrangements. The Air Services Agreements are attached as Appendix III.
- 5. The delegations initialed today a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) regarding designation of airlines. The MoU is attached as Appendix IV.
- 6. The two delegations agreed that the designated airlines of each Contracting Party shall be entitled to operate any number of frequencies per week with any type of aircraft for passenger/combi/pure cargo flights in each direction as specified in the ASA and its Annex.
- 7. The Scandinavian delegation proposed the introduction of an EU standard clause on fair competition into the ASAs. The Kuwaiti delegation stated that it was not in a position to accept the introduction of the clause.
- 8. The two delegations agreed that, pending the signature and entry into force of the agreements and the MoU, they would apply on an administrative basis the provisions of the agreements and the MoU, to the extent possible under national law.
