## **AGREED MINUTES**

A delegation representing jointly the Governments of Denmark, Norway and Sweden, and a delegation representing the Aeronautical Authorities of the Republic of Mauritius, met in Stockholm on 18-19 April 2013 for negotiations on Air Services Agreements between their respective countries.

The talks were held in a very friendly and cordial atmosphere. Lists of the two delegations are attached as Appendices I and II.

The delegations agreed upon and initialed Air Services Agreements between Denmark, Norway and Sweden, respectively, and Mauritius, Appendix III. They also agreed upon and initialed a Memorandum of Understanding concerning the designation of airlines and the cooperation within Scandinavian Airlines System, Appendix IV.

Both delegations agreed to recommend to their respective Governments the formal signing of the Agreements and the MoU. To that effect, they shall endeavor to complete their respective constitutional procedures for approval as soon as possible.

With regard to Article 6 of the draft ASA, the delegation of Mauritius indicated that, notwithstanding the provisions thereof, a levy of MRU 30 cents per liter is payable on petroleum products taken on board aircraft from local suppliers in Mauritius for the protection of the environment.

The delegations agreed to recommend their respective concerned authorities to engage in a discussion on the conclusion of an agreement on the avoidance of double taxation, as appropriate.

Recognizing that the entry into force of the Agreements and the MoU may require some time, the delegations agreed, to the extent possible under national law, to apply the provisions of the Agreements and the MoU on an administrative basis, pending their entry into force.
