Purpose of processing your personal data

The Authority processes personal data for the following purpose:

Legal basis for processing your personal data

The legal basis for processing your personal data comes from: Danish Air Navigation Act No. 1149 of 13/10-2017

Categories of personal data

The Authority processes the following categories of personal data on you:

Name, address, aircraft registration, documentation for authorization to sign for the company



Transfer to recipients in other countries, including to international organisations

In connection with the supervision of the Ministry of the Danish Transport, Construction and Housing Authority, ICAO (International Civil Aviation Organization) may require documents with your personal data delivered as part of the audit. ICAO is a United Nations organization based in Canada.

Filing of your personal data

The data the Authority may keep on record are regularly forwarded to the Danish National Archives in accordance with the rules of the Danish Archives Act and the provisions laid down by the Danish National Archives. Data we receive that are not subject to the Authority's duty to keep records will be deleted when we no longer need them.

Your rights

According to the Data Protection Regulation, you have a number of rights regarding the processing of your personal data by us. If you want to exercise your rights, please contact us.

Right to see your data

You have the right to see the data we process on you (the right of access to documents), or to apply for access to documents.

Right of correction
